MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR

Spring is here and brings with it a 10% average increase in all our costs, but the lead story in this bulletin is about the work Groundwork and Cheshire West and Chester Council (CWaC) have been doing to help us reach our target of net zero. Some of our costs have reduced as a result of the efforts made to achieve this environmental target. I would encourage you all to take advantage of any sustainability initiatives as they arise.

Lack of parking spaces is a major problem on the estate, exacerbated by the closure of the Park and Ride and the spaces that were allocated for private parking to local businesses. It has led to people parking illegally, made it difficult for people to get to work and can discourage people from visiting our businesses.

The BID has been making representation to the council about the problems that the Park and Ride closure is causing. However, we may get more success by individually contacting Rose McArthur, Director of Transport and Highways at Cheshire West and Chester Council, requesting that at least the car park is opened if not the Park and Ride as well. The CCTV has again been delayed, this time by concerns with the structural integrity of some of the lighting columns. OneTek is liaising with CWaC's lighting department to overcome their concerns.

The delays however have had an upside.
The camera manufacturers consider our project to be highly innovative and a great case study which has meant the capability of the cameras is hugely improved compared to what we first considered.

Elsewhere, training courses have been a great success and businesses are filling up the places as soon as they come out. In light of this, the board has approved extra funding this year to ensure everyone who needs a place can get one.

There is a lot of helpful information in this Spring Bulletin which I would encourage you all to check out.

THE ROAD TO NET ZERO

In the BID 2 proposal for West Chester Commercial BID, it was outlined that the BID is committed to working towards the creation of a net zero business park.

As part of this, the BID will be focusing on developing and delivering sustainable business support initiatives to support both the COP 26 and net zero agendas.

Schemes in line with this could include carbon literacy training, feasibility assessments for smart renewable energy networks, business resilience support to manage extreme weather conditions, energy audits and net zero related activity.

With the above in mind, the BID team has set aside a budget for these projects which will be utilised in the future.

In the interim however, Groundwork has been liaising with CWaC to facilitate initial short-term support which is being funded through the government's Shared Prosperity Fund.

The aim of this is to enable companies in the region to identify opportunities where they could reduce their energy usage and begin working towards net zero.

Part of a wider scheme entitled 'Race to Zero', it is expected that grants will be available later on in the year to support companies who have registered with the service.

What is available as part of Race to Zero?

- Funded telephone consultation support
- On-site audits for larger energy users
- Online information sheets and FAQs detailing energy efficiency and renewables

THE LATEST ON THE CCTV PROJECT

There have been a few setbacks to the installation of the CCTV and ANPR cameras.

OneTek, the supplier of the CCTV infrastructure, are in talks with the lighting department regarding the structural integrity of the lighting columns

structural integrity of the lighting column that the cameras will be mounted on.

Despite this however, the delays have meant that a number of key improvements have been possible

These include:

- Increased resolution (20MP up from 15MP)
- ANPR capabilities across all cameras providing internal movement data
- Al analytics for searching, event discovery and people counting
- Audio analytics which can 'listen' for the sound of glass smashing
- Triple redundancy for recording this records locally within camera, to the cloud and to our servers
- Ten-year warranty instead of five

The BID will keep you updated over the coming weeks and months regarding the progress of the project.

SUSTAINABILITY PROJECT RECEIVES NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Efforts to make a popular Chester attraction more environmentally-friendly have been recognised at the National Energy Efficiency Awards.

A wide range of sustainability improvements have been installed at Blacon Adventure Playground thanks to funding from housing provider Sanctuary as part of the organisation's commitment to achieving net zero carbon emissions.

The project was awarded third place in the Multi-measure Project of the Year category. Designed by sustainability consultancy Anthesis and installed by Hewer FM, the upgrades include new solar panels, energy efficient lighting and an air source heat pump, while hands-on learning materials have been added too. These are

designed to encourage visitors to find out more about sustainability.



The upgrades have already reduced CO2 emissions at Blacon Adventure Playground by more than five tonnes a year, while Avenue Services is now working with CWaC to deliver further improvements with the long-term goal of becoming net zero.
